



# **Guide to Charities Providing Grants and Funding**

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## Introduction

This guide includes information about a number of charities which provide grants and funding to help children living with disabilities. The grants vary in value, purpose and eligibility criteria. This guide is designed to provide basic information about each charity to help you to judge whether they may be suitable for your family's needs. For detailed information about a charity including eligibility and terms and conditions, please visit their website.

Although charities have been included in this guide based on available information, unfortunately there is no guarantee that they will be able to offer financial assistance to your family. Many of these charities receive a lot of applications and are unable to support each one. If your application with one charity is unsuccessful, you may need to look elsewhere for this support.

What they offer	Funding for specialist equipment, computers, software and extra tuition for children with disabilities to help them with their education.
Examples	iPad, laptop etc.
Typical grant value	£400
How to apply	Contact Able Kidz by phone or email before making application. Written letter describing child's circumstances and how the charity can help, along with an outline of costs. Letter in support of application from teacher or educational professional outlining educational difficulty and how item might help. Receipt needs to be sent to Able Kidz afterwards.
Eligibility	School age (under 18) children in the UK. Not means tested so no financial information required.
Turnaround time	If nothing received within 12 weeks, assume application was unsuccessful.

## Action For Kids

What they offer	Funding for specialist mobility equipment but not static equipment, standing frames, ramps, storage or anything to be used exclusively at school.
Examples	Powered and manual wheelchairs, specialist buggies, walkers, specialist trikes, mobile hoists, car seats and harnesses.
Typical grant value	Not specified, but can be over £2500
How to apply	Arrange assessment with representative of equipment supplier and occupational therapist/physiotherapist. If equipment cost is over £2500, two assessments are required. Send the quotation from the supplier(s) and a letter of support from the physiotherapist (including why your child needs this specific brand, its functions and benefits) along with the application form. Family income is not taken into account unless it is above £85,000 gross.
Eligibility	Anyone up to the age of 25 who is resident in the UK and requires specialist mobility equipment to become more independent.
Turnaround time	3-9 months (but can vary: please contact them to enquire)

Other notes	Also offers support to young adults (18-25 year olds) living with disabilities in London to help with finding and securing employment.

Eligibility	For children and young people between 3 and 17 with a disability or illness in the UK.
Turnaround time	Depends on when applications are submitted. Cut-offs are 31st December for February meeting, 31st March for May meeting, 30th June for August meeting and 30th September for November meeting.

Turnaround time	Up to 10 weeks to process application.

Typical grant value	Up to £5000 (this value may be for community organisations rather than individuals).
How to apply	Fill in online application form including financial details. Requires letter of support confirming the condition and that the equipment is appropriate and an independent quote from the supplier.
Eligibility	Applicants must live in the UK and be aged 18 or under, living with a disability or life-limiting illness.
Turnaround time	2-4 weeks

Eligibility	Disabled children under 18 in DT Dorset postcodes.
Turnaround time	Applications are reviewed every 6 weeks.

What they offer	Grants towards specialist equipment, transport or housing adaptations. Cannot purchase internet items or mobility scooters.
Examples	No specific examples.
Typical grant value	No maximum.
How to apply	Complete application form and provide a letter of support from a healthcare professional (e.g., doctor, consultant, physiotherapist, occupational therapist or social worker). Requires evidence of financial need and quotation from supplier.
Eligibility	People with disabilities in financial need. Not age restricted. Item cannot be available from statutory services e.g., NHS.
Turnaround time	Application will be acknowledged within 7 days, with a decision made within 10 days.

What they offer	<b>Up to 80%</b> funding for some specialist equipment. Remaining cost is usually provided by the family or can be obtained from separate charity.
Examples	Powered wheelchairs, therapy tricycles, sensory equipment, car seats and harnesses, buggies.
Typical grant value	Not specified.
How to apply	Complete application form. Requires a questionnaire/letter of support from occupational therapist or physiotherapist.
Eligibility	Aged up to 19 years old, with chronic illness or disability, living in the UK with a household income below £45,000.
Turnaround time	Varies depending on availability of equipment – it appears that Caudwell Children orders the equipment directly and so delivery time is dependent on stock levels. Can take up to 6 months.

How to apply	Complete application form (available under 'Downloads' at bottom of page; if equipment is not specifically designed for children with disability or illness, a letter of recommendation from a doctor, nurse or physiotherapist is required). Application requires letter of support from social worker, key worker, health visitor, teacher or equivalent and letter from doctor confirming diagnosis, along with any quotes received and proof of name and address. Children's Hope Foundation asks for a feedback form or short video about the impact of the funding for your child.
Eligibility	Children and young people up to the age of 25 years.
Turnaround time	If no response received in 13 weeks, assume application unsuccessful.

How to apply	Call to check eligibility. Get up to 3 quotes and call again to request application form. Complete application form. Requires a professional reference letter including details and how the equipment will help from occupational therapist, physiotherapist, hospital consultant or member of SENCO team.
Eligibility	Anyone up to the age of 25 years in the UK who is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance.
Turnaround time	Applications are reviewed quarterly, but in chronological order, meaning it may take more than 3 months to hear back.

Eligibility	Children and young people up to 25 years old who live within a 50-mile radius of Stourbridge (West Midlands) who have been unable to secure state funding.

Eligibility	Children and young people aged 5-18 who are living with a serious or life-limiting illness or disability in the highest areas of deprivation in the UK (as specified on their website), who have not had a dream granted to them before. Children should be in receipt of DLA/PIP (the appropriate levels are stated on their website, but usually involves the moderate or higher rate for the care component).
Turnaround time	Charity will contact referrer with decision within 2 weeks. Some capacity for urgent dreams (extended age range of 2-18 and extended postcode area).

Turnaround time	6-12 weeks.

How to apply	Register on Family Portal, provide letter of benefit entitlement and document with full name of child, provide contact details for social worker, key worker/lead professional, health visitor, teacher etc.
Eligibility	Low-income families (main carer in receipt of universal credit, child tax credit, working tax credit, income-based Jobseeker's allowance, income related employment support allowance, income support, housing benefit or pension credit). Up to the age of 17, with some further support for 18–24-year-olds. Requiring support in at least 3 of these areas: personal care, access to social activities, education, communication, supervision and vigilance, medical or therapeutic treatment or condition management, physical environment and specialist resources.
Turnaround time	Usually find out decision within 30 working days.
